Enjoy some fresh air this summer and have an adventure spotting the art work in the trees while walking, scooting or cycling around the 3 mile, entirely off-road, circular route.



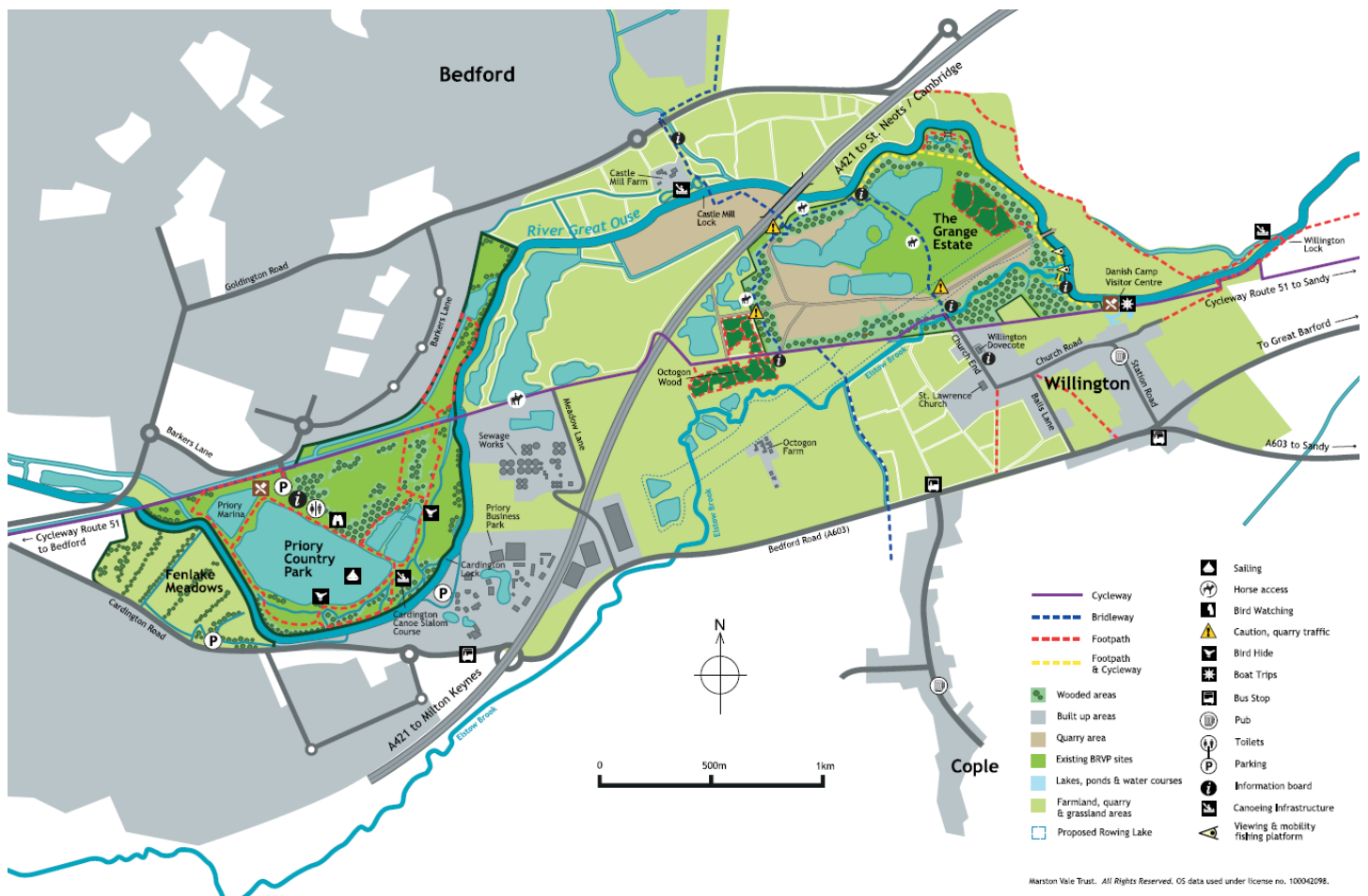

**How to get there:**

**Cycling** - It is 3 miles from Priory Marina in Bedford to Danish Camp along Route 51 which is an entirely off-road route

**Public Transport**— Bus number 27 from Bedford Bus Station to Willington Lower School, which is a 5 min walk from Danish Camp

**Driving**— Danish Camp have a customer car park. You can reach this via Station Road from the A603, Bedford Road.
